In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Berhampore** Police Station Case No.**1095** dated **30.08.2019** under Sections **498A/304B/376/511/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code read with Section **4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act wherein Charge-Sheet has been submitted vide Charge-Sheet No.15 dated January 23, 2020 under Sections **498A/304B/34** of the Indian Penal code read with Sections **3/4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act giving rise to G.R. Case No.3779 of 2019.

Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

The police filed charge sheet, *inter alia*, under Sections 498A/304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioner claims to be out of India at the relevant point of time.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also

subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 39 of 2023 is disposed of.
