Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

The statement of the victim recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure squarely implicates both the petitioners in the incident of kidnapping.

Consequently, considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.

C.R.M. (A) 71 of 2023 is dismissed.
