By the order dated 17th January, 2023, the parties were given an opportunity to sort out the matter by way of a direction of the Bank to hand over the title deeds to the petitioner by 10:30 a.m. today.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the Bank submits that the direction has been complied with. Counsel further submits that the writ petition may be disposed of with a further direction on the Bank to fix the date for execution and registration of a conveyance for sale of the immovable property by the Bank in favour of the petitioner.

WPA 435 of 2022 is accordingly disposed of with the direction on the respondent No. 2 being The Federal Bank to execute the deed of conveyance and register the same within a period of eight weeks from date.
