The fundamental issue in this application is with regard to the disposal of an application under Order XXVI Rule 9 of the Code of Civil Procedure which is pending for a considerable period.

Since the opposite parties entered appearance through the learned advocate, service of notice upon the opposite parties stands dispensed with.

It is submitted that the suit is pending before the learned Judge, 6th Bench, City Civil Court, Calcutta, but there is no Presiding Officer posted.
