In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Uluberia** Police Station Case No.**249 of 2022** dated **18.08.2022** under Sections **498A/302/304B/406/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and subsequently Charge Sheet submitted being Charge Sheet No.234 of 2022, dated 14.11.2022 under Sections **498A/304B/306/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

The police filed charge sheet, *inter alia*, under Sections 498A/304B/306/34 of the Indian Penal Code after conducting an investigation, *inter alia*, under Section 302 thereof.

The husband was granted bail by the jurisdictional Court.

The petitioners before us are the in-laws of the victim.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court

on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 331 of 2023 is disposed of.
