Learned Advocate for state files status report of Tamluk P.S. case No. – 238/17, dated 17th May, 2017 from which it appears that the case arising out of Tamluk Police case no. 238/17 has been disposed off on 12th April, 2023 and accused / petitioner Krittibas Kar has been acquitted from the charges u/s 376/420 of the Indian Penal Code framed against him on 8th December, 2017.
