Affidavit-of-service filed by the learned advocate for the petitioner be kept with the record.

In spite of service, none appears on behalf of the State-respondents.

The husband of the petitioner was an approved Group-‘D’ staff of a Secondary school and died-in-harness on November 08, 2021.

The Pension Payment Order of the employee concerned was issued on November 17, 2022 in pursuance whereof the petitioner received the gratuity and arrear pension on November 18, 2022.

In the instant writ petition the prayer of the petitioner is a writ of mandamus be issued commanding the respondents to pay interest on the said amount of gratuity for the delayed payment.

It is now well settled that the petitioner is entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The respondents, the concerned Treasury Officer in particular are, therefore, directed to pay interest @ 8% per annum gratuity and arrear family pension from the date of death of the employee concerned till the date of such payment.

The payment as aforesaid shall be made within the period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default, the said arrear amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A 2390 of 2023 stands disposed of with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
