This is an application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for expeditious disposal of the Complaint Case No.CC/9/2022 on account of fetal disease of Cancer suffered by the petitioner no.1, Dr. Lalita Menon.

Considering the nature of prayer, i.e., expeditious disposal, I find hardly any necessity to ask for service of notice upon the opposite parties. Thus, service of notice upon the opposite parties stands dispensed with.

The West Bengal State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kolkata, is requested to dispose of the Complaint Case No.CC/9/2022 as expeditiously as possible.

With the above observation, the revisional application, being CO 410 of 2023, stands disposed of.

the West Bengal State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kolkata, forthwith.
