The present revisional application is against an order of acquittal passed by the appellate court. According to the provisions of CrPC, the petitioner ought to have preferred special leave to appeal.

Mr. Apalak Basu, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that he intends to prefer such special leave to appeal challenging the order passed by the appellate court.

Accordingly, CRR 504 of 2023 is dismissed as not pressed.

The petitioner is granted liberty to prefer special leave to appeal.

In case, there is any delay in preferring the special leave to appeal the period, which has lapsed would be taken into consideration for pendency of the revisional application because of an inadvertent advice/mistaken belief.
