In Re:- An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with NDPS Case No. 39 of 2020 arising out of Dalkhola P.S. Case No.264 of 2020 dated 10.11.2020 under Sections 21(C)/29 of the NDPS Act.

Petitioner is in custody for two years and three months.

He prays for bail.

Learned Advocate for the State opposes the bail prayer.

He submits chemical examiner's report.

We have considered the materials on record including the chemical examiner's report. There are ample materials to show recovery of narcotics above commercial quantity from the petitioner.

Under such circumstances, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

Trial court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same at an early date preferably within one year from the next date fixed for recording evidence without granting unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.
