The instant appeal was filed under Section 374(2)
of the Cr. P.C., 1973.

Being aggrieved by the judgment and order dated
16th September, 2003 passed by the learned Additional
Chief Judicial Magistrate, South 24 Parganas at Alipore
in T.R. Case No. 219 of 1999 thereby acquitting the
opposite party no. 1 from the charges framed under
Section 630 of the Companies Act, 1956.

By an order dated 4th February, 2004, the then Co-
ordinate bench of this Court had granted special leave to
prefer the instant appeal against the aforesaid judgment
in CRM 19 of 2004.
