The petitioner complains of alleged inaction on the part of the Chanditala Police Station. She has complained that she is being obstructed from using a land under a leasehold estate/property.

Counsel for the State submits that the police have received a report from the BL & LRO that no formal permission for conversion of the land to use it for pisciculture has been obtained. The digging up of the land for creating a pond would amount to changing the nature and character of the land. The land stands in the name of a deity (Debattar property). The name of the petitioner has not been found in the records by the BL & LRO.

In the aforesaid circumstances, the petitioner expects this Court to put a judicial seal over a gross illegality.

In the above circumstances, WPA 3063 of 2020 shall stand dismissed with costs assessed at Rs. 7,500/-, payable to the Chanditala Police Station by the petitioner.
