A report is received from the Learned Registrar Administration (L&OM) along with notice wherein it has been submitted that the sole petitioner Kharen Barman @ Ray has expired. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner nor from any of the legal heirs to continue with the case. The Notice sent through Registered Post has been returned with the endorsement that the petitioner has expired. In spite of said notice there is no representation by the legal heirs.
