Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application upon Mr. Saryati Datta, learned advocate, who ordinarily appears for the State. His appointment may be regularised by the concerned authorities.

On perusal of the contents of this revisional application, I find that the case was initiated in the year 2021 and the petitioners approached this Court at a stage when the investigation, *prima facie* reflects, was still continuing. Having considered the stage at which the petitioners approached this Court and the issues so raised by Mr. Basu, learned advocate appearing for the petitioners, I find that there is civil dispute between the residents of the same building. However, appreciating the factual circumstances it would not be fit and proper within the scheme of Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to interfere at this stage.

The petitioners would be at liberty to approach this Court at an appropriate stage of the proceedings.

With the aforesaid observations, the revisional application being CRR 679 of 2023 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
