This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed with a prayer for expeditious disposal of an application under Order XXVI Rule 9 of the Code of Civil Procedure in connection with Title Suit No.187 of 2016 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sealdah, South 24-Parganas.

Considering the nature of prayer, i.e., expeditious disposal, I find hardly any necessity to ask for service of notice upon the opposite parties. Thus, service of notice upon the opposite parties stands dispensed with.

The learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sealdah, South 24-Parganas, is requested to dispose of the application under Order XXVI Rule 9 of the Code of Civil Procedure on the date fixed for hearing, i.e., on 27th March, 2023, positively, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the parties to the suit.
