The petitioner complains of illegal and unauthorized construction.

Allegation is that the complaint lodged against such unauthorized construction has not been taken up for consideration till date.

Learned advocate representing the private respondent no. 6 denies the allegation of the petitioner.

Learned advocate representing the Howrah Municipal Corporation submits, upon instruction that, necessary steps have been taken in response to the complaint lodged by the petitioner.

Documents have been produced before this Court by the learned advocate for the Corporation in support of the submission that steps have been taken in accordance with law to deal with the issue.

I have perused the communication made by the Assistant Engineer, Borough-VII, Howrah Municipal Corporation dated December 7, 2023 Vide Memo No. 1067/AE/B-VII/23-24/.
