The petitioners were involved in an incident of assault where one of the injured suffered injuries on the spinal Cord.

The injury suffered was grievous hurt in nature.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the complicity of the petitioners in the incident, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is **rejected**.
