This application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India has been filed with a prayer for expeditious disposal of the Matrimonial Suit No.219 of 2019 pending before the learned Additional District & Session Judge, Fast Track Court, Baruipur, South 24-Parganas, under Section 27(1)(d) of the Special Marriage Act, 1954.

Considering the facts and circumstances, I do not find any reason to serve notice upon the opposite party. Thus, service of notice upon the opposite party stands dispensed with.
