**C.R.M. (DB) 834 of 2023**

Heard the learned Advocates for the parties.

We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner is in custody for 388 days. Co-accused is on bail.

Keeping in mind the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of detention suffered by the petitioner, we are inclined to extend the same relief to him.

Accordingly, the petitioner viz., Prabir Gupta shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat, Nadia subject to condition that he shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
