Apparently, explosive devices were used in the incident of assault when persons received grievous hurt.

Petitioners stand implicated in the incident of assault.

In such circumstances, considering the gravity of the offence and involvement of the petitioners in the incident we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

CRM (A) 969 of 2023 is rejected.
