Ananya Bandyopadhyay, J.:-

The instant criminal appeal is preferred by the petitioner being aggrieved and dissatisfied with an order and judgment dated 8.11.2000 passed by Learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, 2nd Court, Midnapore, acquitted the accused persons in connection with C.R. Case No. 927 of 1994 under Section 248(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and discharged the accused persons from the said case.
