Mr. Arijit Ganguly, learned advocate appears for the State and hands over a report submitted by the Officer-in-Charge, Swarupnagar Police Station with regard to the accused, Rahima Fakir @ Salma Fakir. The report is enclosed with number of documents including that of the Electoral Registration Officer, 151- Belapur Assembly Constituency. The report of the Electoral Registration Officer questions the genuinity of the EPIC Card which was submitted.
