None appears on behalf of the petitioner. This matter is pending in the list since 1.5.2023 and has been called on each day of working of this Court since that date. In spite of that no one is appearing. The petitioner is found to be not interest in this case. Therefore, the same is taken up today for disposal on merit.

The petitioner has prayed for quashing of the proceedings in CS No. 0044759 of 2015 u/s. 138/141 of the N.I. Act pending before the Court the learned Magistrate, 19th Court at Calcutta. According to the petitioner, there is no cognizable case made out against him and thus the proceedings only amount to abuse of the process of Court.

On perusal of the entire materials available on record and the grounds made up by the petitioner I am constrained to find that the grounds thereof are not sufficient and cogent enough to warrant this Court's interference into the impugned order. Hence, in my considered opinion the revision is liable to be dismissed.
