The criminal revision of 2020 is moved by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the instant revision the petitioner has prayed for expeditious disposal of ACGR Case No. 1333 of 2018 arising out of Patuli P.S. Case No. 51 of 2018 under Sections 341/323/506/114 of the Indian Penal Code pending before the Learned 7th Judicial Magistrate at Alipore.

As there is no representation on behalf of the State, Mr. Mr. Mirza Firoj Ahmed Begg, learned counsel who is present in Court is appointed to represent the State. His appointment be regularized.

Considering the fact that the proceedings in this case is under Sections 341/323/506/114 of the Indian Penal Code, the revisional application is disposed of with the direction to the trial court to dispose of the ACGR Case No. 1333 of 2018 arising out of Patuli P.S. Case No. 51 of 2018 under Sections 341/323/506/114 of the Indian Penal Code, pending before the

learned 7th Judicial Magistrate at Alipore, as expeditiously as possibly preferably within six months from the date of this order.

The revisional application being CRR 917 of 2020, is, accordingly disposed of.
