Petitioner has preferred the present revisional application for expeditious disposal of the case being C-354 of 2019 pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 3<sup>rd</sup> Court, Barrackpore.

Learned advocate submits that pursuant to the present application being preferred before this Court the examination of the accused under Section 251 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has already been completed and date has been fixed for evidence. The next date is fixed on 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2023.

Learned Judicial Magistrate, 3<sup>rd</sup> Court, Barrackpore is directed to fix at least one date in a month for the purposes of this case. Efforts be taken so that the prosecution evidence is completed by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. The examination under Section 313 of the Code of Criminal Procedure be completed by 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2024. Defence be granted three months' time for adducing defence evidence. Learned trial court is directed to pronounce its verdict by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2024.

With the aforesaid observations, CRR 1001 of 2023 is disposed of.

Pending application, if any, is consequently disposed of.
