Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits he is in custody for three years and eight months. There is inordinate delay in trial. Co-accused has been granted bail.

Learned Counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. He stands on the same footing with co-accused and is entitled to similar relief.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Judge, Special Court under

NDPS Act-cum-Additional District & Sessions Judge, 4th Court at Malda, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate the witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever or commit similar offences in future.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail automatically without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail is, accordingly, allowed.
