Report of the Superintendent of Police and the District Magistrate filed in Court be taken on record.

It appears from such reports that police personnel were lax in collecting the postmortem report. Apparently, police authorities took steps against the erring police personnel.

It appears from the postmortem report that the victim committed suicide.

The materials in the case diary as against the petitioner apparently are omnibus and general in nature.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under

Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall cooperate with the investigations till its conclusion and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is **allowed**.
