The petitioner is the wife, who claims expeditious disposal of the Misc. Case No.25 of 2022 filed in connection with Divorce Suit No.4 of 2021, renumbered as Matrimonial Suit No.168 of 2022. The said misc. case is pending before the learned Additional District Judge, Gangarampur at Buniadpur, Dakshin Dinajpur. It is submitted that no other interlocutory applications, arising out of the misc. case is pending.

This court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the pending miscellaneous case, on an urgent basis.

This court has not gone into the merits of the misc. case. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application upon the opposite party, would not be necessary. The prayer is innocuous and very reasonable.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to dispose of the pending miscellaneous case within a period of six months from the next date fixed, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and upon granting adequate opportunity to the opposite party to contest the proceedings. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite party.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
