Order dated October 15, 2022 passed by the Sessions Court granting anticipatory bail to the private opposite party is under challenge in the present application on the ground of post bail misconduct.

Learned advocate appearing for the State relies upon a written instructions and submits that, the police did not find any substance in the claim of the petitioner that he received threatening phone call from the private opposite party.

State and the private opposite party are represented.

In view of the allegation of post bail misconduct by the private opposite party remaining unsubstantiated, we find no reason to interfere with the order dated October 15, 2022.

CRM (DB) 1227 of 2023 is, accordingly, dismissed.
