None appears on behalf of the petitioners. This matter is pending in the list since 01.05.2023 and has been called on each day of working of this Court since that date. In spite of that no one is appearing. The petitioner is found to be not interest in this case. Therefore, the same is taken up today for disposal on merit.

In this case the petitioner has prayed for quashing of the proceeding being G.R. Case No. 1516 of 2014, now pending in the Court of Chief Metropolitan Magistrate at Calcutta. The case was lodged by dint of FIR being Shakespeare Sarani P.S. case no. 225 of 2014 dated 11th July, 2014 under Sections 120B/406/467/468/471/420 of the Indian Penal Code.

According to the petitioner, the FIR has not made out in case against him eligible for a trial. Thus, he says that the criminal proceeding is not maintainable and has prayed for quashing of the same.

On perusal of the entire materials available on record and the grounds made up by the petitioner I am constrained to find that the grounds thereof are not sufficient and cogent enough to warrant this Court's interference into the impugned order. Hence, in my considered opinion the revision is liable to be dismissed.

Criminal Revision being CRR 804 of 2015 is dismissed.
