This revisional application has been filed with a prayer for expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No.631 of 2021 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 8th Court, Alipore, South 24-Parganas.

Considering the facts and circumstances, I do not find any reason to ask the petitioner to serve notice upon the opposite parties. Thus, service of notice upon the opposite parties stands dispensed with.
