Affidavit-of-service filed by the learned advocate for the petitioner be kept with the record.

None appears on behalf of the State respondents in spite of service.

The husband of the petitioner was an approved non-teaching staff (Clerk) of a Secondary school and he died-in-harness on October 21, 2020.

The Pension Payment Order of the concerned employee was issued on February 01, 2023 in pursuance whereof the petitioner received the arrear family pension on February 23, 2023.

In the instant writ petition the prayer of the petitioner is a writ of mandamus be issued commanding the respondents to pay interest on the said amount of arrear family pension for the delayed payment.

It is now well settled that the petitioner is entitled to the interest, as prayed for.

The respondents, the concerned Treasury Officer in particular are, therefore, directed to pay interest @ 8% per annum on the arrear amount of family pension from the date of death of the teacher concerned till the date of such payment.

The payment as aforesaid shall be made within the period of eight weeks from the date of communication of this order, in default, the said arrear amount shall fetch an additional interest of 2% per annum.

W.P.A. 9291 of 2023 stands disposed of, with the above directions. There shall be no order as to costs.
