In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Pursurah** Police Station Case No. **59** of **2023** dated **08.03.2023** under Sections **341/ 323/ 325/ 354B/ 379/ 504/ 506/ 509/ 34** of the Indian Penal Code and Section **12** of POCSO Act.

Apparently, an incident of assault developed between local persons. Persons suffered injuries, which were not classified as grievous hurt. In such incident of assault apparently wearing apparels got torn.

There are statements recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code of the two victims.

Considering the gravity of the offence and involvement of the petitioners therein and considering the fact that large numbers of persons were involved in the incident, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two

sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a month till the conclusion of investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accuseds and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
