Mr. Chowdhury, learned advocate appearing for the opposite party no.2 submits a photostat copy of the order passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sealdah wherein it reflects that final report has been submitted as mistake of fact and there has been prayer for discharge of the accused persons at the instance of the State/Investigating Officer.

Having regard to the subject-matter of the revisional application and the prayer so advanced, I am of the view that the present revisional application has become infructuous.
