1. Affidavit-of-service filed in court today be kept on record.
2. The appointment of Ms. Rupsha Chakraborty, learned counsel for the State, be regularized by the State.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner submitted a deed for registration. However, the registration is not being granted on the ground that the stamp papers on which the document was executed are forged.
4. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is agreeable to put in the cash equivalent of the amount of the forged stamp papers.
5. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in the event the petitioner deposits such amount, there is no impediment on the part of the respondents to register the document and hand over the same to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, WPA 9416 of 2023 is disposed of by directing the petitioner to deposit the cash equivalent of the allegedly forged stamp papers on which the deed-in-question was executed.

7. Upon such cash being deposited with the registering authorities, the respondents shall complete the registration and hand over the registered document to the petitioner, preferably within three weeks from the date of deposit of such cash equivalent by the petitioner.

There will be no order as to costs.
