In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Chakdaha** Police Station Case No.**122 of 2023** dated **06.03.2023** under Sections **341/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections **25/27** of the Arms Act.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

Apparently, an incident of assault took place.

Two firearms were used. Both the firearms turn out to be licensed.

No injury of gunshot was received by any of the victims.

The case diary does not disclose any injury being suffered by any person.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners will report before the Investigating Officer once a month

till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 1881 of 2023 is, thus, disposed of.
