The present revision of the year 2019 is against an order dated 30.04.2019 passed by the Learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, 3rd Court, Tamluk in connection with Nandakumar P.S. Case No. 91 of 2018 dated 20.03.2018 under Sections 498A/304B/302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, corresponding to G.R. Case No. 507 of 2018.
