In Re:- An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Panrui** Police Station Case No. **147** of **2022** dated **09.11.2022** under Sections 498A/307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Sections 3/ 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

Police filed charge-sheet.

Petitioner is the husband of the de-facto complainant.

Police complaint was lodged eight years after marriage.

Statement of the neighbours leveled omnibus and general allegations as against the petitioner.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the materials in the case diary, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner

shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
