The report filed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, South 24 Parganas, Alipore dated 12.6.2023 stated that the opposite party no. 2 to have expired on 25.2.2014 supported by a death certificate, let the said report be kept with the record.

The instant revisional application has been filed being aggrieved by an order dated 5.8.2010 passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kakdwip in Case No. M 138 of 2009 under Section 125 of the Criminal Procedure Code directing the petitioners to pay a sum of Rs 750/- per month to the opposite party no. 2.

This court finds that the impugned order does not suffer from any illegality or impropriety and as such this court is not inclined to interfere with the same and accordingly, the instant revisional application is dismissed.
