The present revision of the year 2019 is against an order and judgment passed on 06.03.2019 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, 2nd Court, Katwa in Criminal Appeal No. 1/2018 arising out Katwa P.S. Case No. 100 of 1995 arising out of M.P. Case No. 67/95 under Sections 467/468/471/420/419/120B of the Indian Penal Code.
