None appears for the petitioner or for the private opposite parties.

Petitioner approached this Court immediately after the process was issued by the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 15th Court, Calcutta. Learned trial court was pleased after perusal of the materials that a case has been made out under the relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code.

Having regard to the primary contentions advanced regarding the representation made by the petitioner, I am of the view that the complainant must be granted an opportunity to adduce their evidence before charge prior to interfering with the proceeding with prayers so advanced in the revisional application.
