The present case relates to Hirapur Police Station Case No. 301 of 2018 dated 06.12.2018. From the enclosures to this revisional application, I do not find that the documents under Section 207 of the Code of Criminal Procedure are yet supplied to the present petitioner or has been enclosed along with this revisional application. Having regard to the same, I am of the view that this revisional application is premature.
