The petitioner is the plaintiff in Title Suit No.166 of 2022, which is pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 2nd Court, Barasat. The petitioner prays for expeditious disposal of the suit as also the application for injunction.

Under such circumstances, this court is of the view that justice would be subserved, if the learned court below is directed to dispose of the said suit as also the application, on an urgent basis.

This court has neither gone into the merits of the application nor into the merits of the suit. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation, enures to the benefit of all the parties. Hence, prior service of this revisional application upon the opposite party, would not be necessary. The prayer is innocuous and very reasonable.

The revisional application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned court below to dispose of the pending application for injunction within two months from the next date fixed. Thereafter, upon disposal of the injunction application, the learned court below shall proceed with the suit and dispose

of the same within a year, without granting unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties and upon granting adequate opportunity to the opposite party to contest the proceedings. The learned court below shall proceed strictly in accordance with law and independently.

Petitioner is directed to serve a copy of this revisional application along with the server copy of this order upon the opposite party.

Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of.

All the parties are directed to act on the basis of the server copy of this order.
