In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Hariharpara** Police Station Case No.**193 of 2023** dated **04.05.2023** under Sections **341/324/325/308/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

There are two police complaints in respect of an incident of assault.

The police complaint of the petitioners apparently is first in point of time.

Be that as it may, in the present police case, two suffered injuries. None of the injuries were classified as grievous hurt.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners will report before the Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court

on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 2043 of 2023 is, thus, disposed of.
