The petitioners seek consideration of their representations dated April 5, 2021 and March 27, 2023.

Without entering into the merits of the said representations, the instant writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent no. 3 being the Officer-on-Special Duty, Assessment Department, Howrah Municipal Corporation to consider the aforesaid representations in accordance with law after giving reasonable opportunity of hearing to all the necessary parties and by passing a reasoned order at the earliest but positively within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of this order.
