Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits there is no direct evidence connecting them with the murder. They have been implicated out of suspicion.

Learned Counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. Petitioners made extra-judicial confession before local villagers. Petitioner no. 2 had motive to commit the crime. Keeping in mind the aforesaid incriminating materials and gravity of the offence, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners at this stage.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.
