Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits he is in custody for about two years. It is also submitted he has been falsely implicated.

Learned Counsel for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits petitioner was identified in the course of test identification parade as one of the miscreants who committed robbery.

We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner was identified in test identification parade. On his showing stolen article was recovered. Under such circumstances, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.
