1. Heard learned Counsel for the parties.
2. Considered the materials placed by the learned Counsel for the parties including the statement of the witnesses and the injury report in respect of the victim.

Regard being had to such facts and submissions, factum of permanent residence of the petitioner, nature of injury sustained by the victim which is not grievous in nature and substantial progress in the investigation, it is directed that the petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of his arrest by the Arresting Officer in connection with G.R.
