The petitioners are the respondents in Title Appeal No.11 of 2021 pending before the learned Additional District Judge, 1st Court, Sealdah, South 24 Parganas. The petitioners pray that the title appeal along with the application which is pending before the learned lower appellate court be disposed of expeditiously.

This court has neither gone into the merits of the pending application nor expressed any opinion on the merits of the pending appeal and the case and counter case of the parties. An order of expeditious disposal of any litigation enures to the benefit of all the parties. The prayer for expeditious disposal is innocuous.

This court is of the view that prior service of the revisional application upon the opposite parties would not be necessary.
