Affidavit of service filed in court today be kept on record.

The petitioner submits that the matter relates to conversion from CPF to GPF.

If that be so the following order is passed:

The petitioner prays for arrear pension for conversion of his account from CPF to GPF. He has been given pension from the date of deposit of all the money which was paid to him against his CPF. But the pension is given only from date of refund of money. He is entitled to get pension from date following the date of retirement. Arrear pension should be given within a period of six weeks from the date of communication of this order. However, the petitioner has submitted that he does not want any interest of the arrear pension amount.

With the above observation and direction, this writ application is disposed of.
